

Number of Incidents in 2023











2023 Incident Response



Emergency Management – 2024 Goals


- Revise the Emergency Operations Plan

2023 Fire Marshal Division Accomplishments

- Adoption of 2018 Fire Code (in accordance with state code)
- Updated fire fees in Munis; first update in 10 years
- Decreased false fire alarm responses by over 22% through enforcement of fire alarm tech responses
- Reduced a six-month lag in issuing permits to no lag time
- Developed first ever guidance book for suppression division with multiple job aids to assist in incident response
- Investigated over 20 fires

2023 Fire Marshal Division Accomplishments

- Completed over 1,600 inspections
- Coordinated the installation of over 700 smoke alarms and developed a cooperative with the American Red Cross to provide smoke alarms
- Developed a guidance sheet on new construction projects to aid developers with City specific requirements
- Coordinated over 120 public education events, impacting over 5,000 children and adults in the community
- Coordinated over 75 special events
